

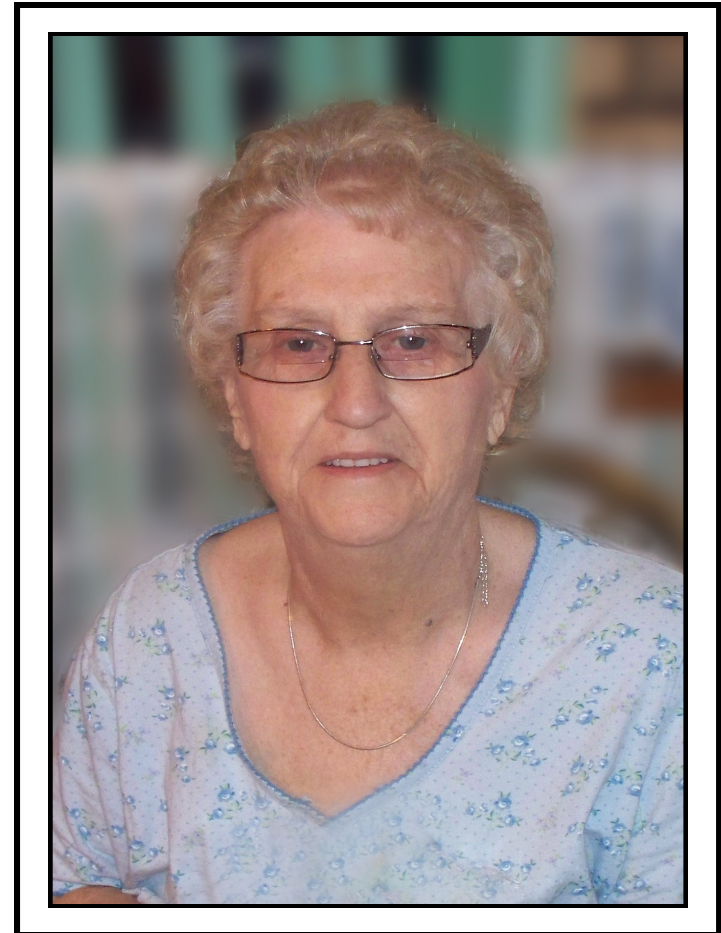
*God looked around His garden
